Directions: From Carharrack Anglican Church turn down Fore Street, take the 2nd right into Sparry Lane, then take 1st right, (continuation of Sparry Lane), down the lane to the blue gate on the right. Park on site and in area of land opposite (signposted).

Details: Garden open, plants for sale, craft/hobby display, board games, table tennis, boules etc., teas and coffees, cakes and cream tea. No dogs. Easily accessible, flat area, accessible to wheelchairs.

Directions: Take A394 towards Helston. At Edgecumbe turn left signed Gweek/Constantine. After 1.3 miles turn right signed Seworgan.

Opposite 'The Old Chapel' take the farm track. Follow the track until just before a bungalow and take a sharp right downhill. Park at the bottom.

Details: Woodland garden (1 acre), hot tub (bring bathing costume and towel!), large accessible conservatory. Light refreshments. Dogs welcome. Room for several cars but 'first in – last out' so car-share if possible. Steps and slopes so not ideal for wheelchairs, although the house, conservatory and toilet are fully accessible.

Directions: From A39 Penryn bypass turn off at Hillhead roundabout following signs for Falmouth; at Union Corner roundabout turn left towards Falmouth; at the traffic lights opposite Falmouth School, turn right; turn left into Kelley Road, continue around corner to T-junction and turn left into Venton Road; Polventon Close is the next turning on the left towards Falmouth. Room for 2 cars on drive or anywhere along Venton Road.

Details: Woodland walk (Tregonigie Woodland) led by Euan (setting off approx. 2.30pm) followed by cream teas at home. Choose whether to join the walk or to stay at the home and relax in the garden or indoors. Ordinary footwear for walk as all paths are of stone chippings. Easy walking with benches if a rest is required. Dogs welcome. Accessibility: gravel driveway, two steps into house.
